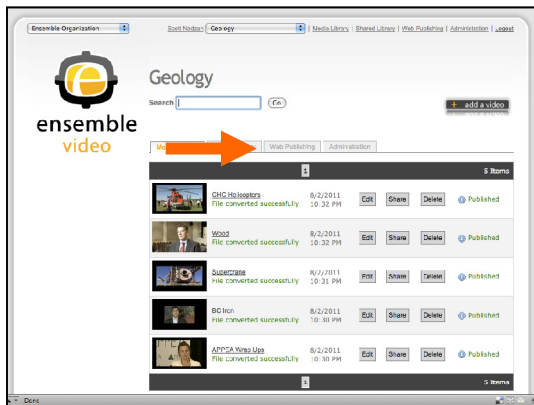

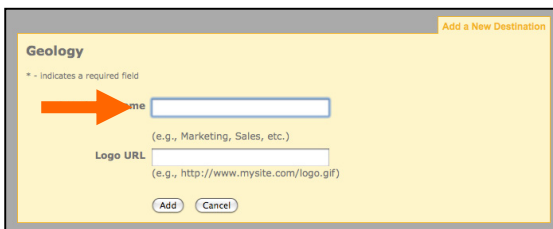
## How-to Create an iTunes Feed.

Click the Web Publishing Tab.



## Create a New Destination

Click on the "Add a New Destination" button to create an iTunes feed.



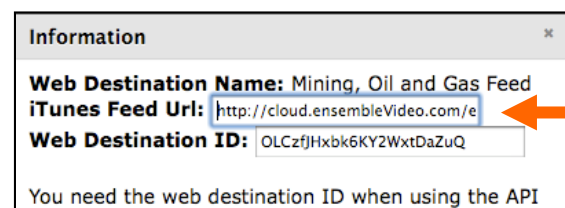
## Enter your Website/ Feed Name

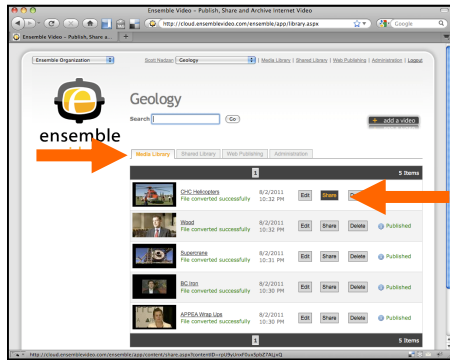

1. Click on the Information Button (blue circle)
2. Copy the iTunes Feed URL



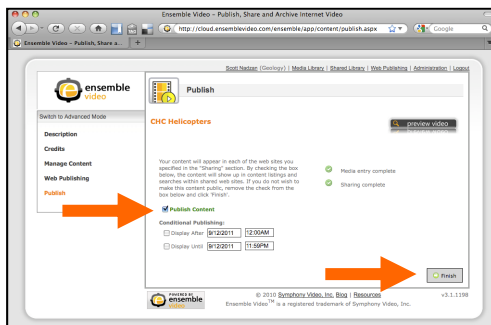
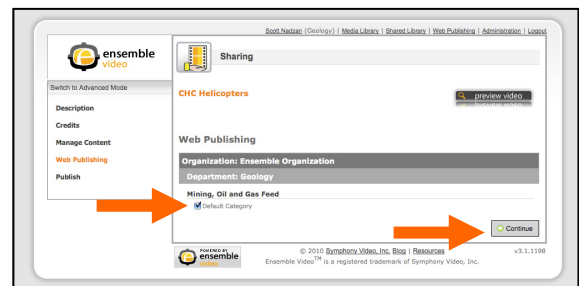


## How-to Publish a Video Entry to iTunes Feed

1. Click the Media Library Tab
2. Go to the Video You want to Publish
3. Click the Share Button

## Select Your iTunes Feed

1. Select your Feed by checking the box
2. Click Continue



## Finish Publishing

1. Make sure Publish Content is Selected
2. Click Finish
3. Your Video is now Published to the iTunes Feed
