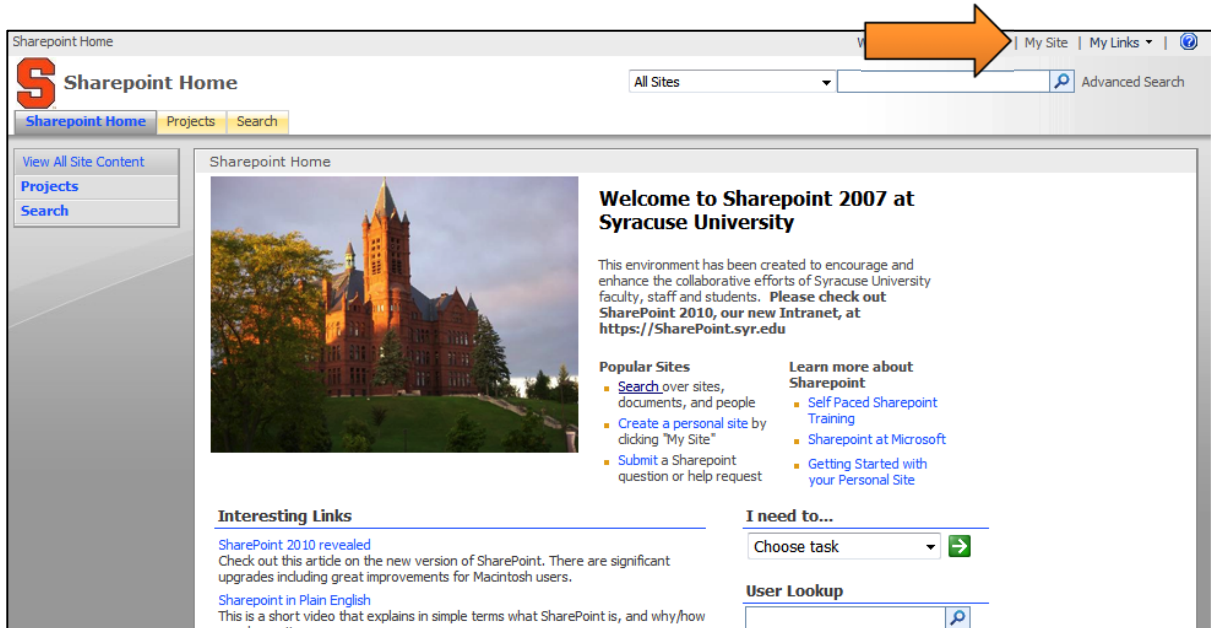


The Ensemble HTML Plug-in can be embedded into Microsoft SharePoint and other management systems to display media content to a group of users.

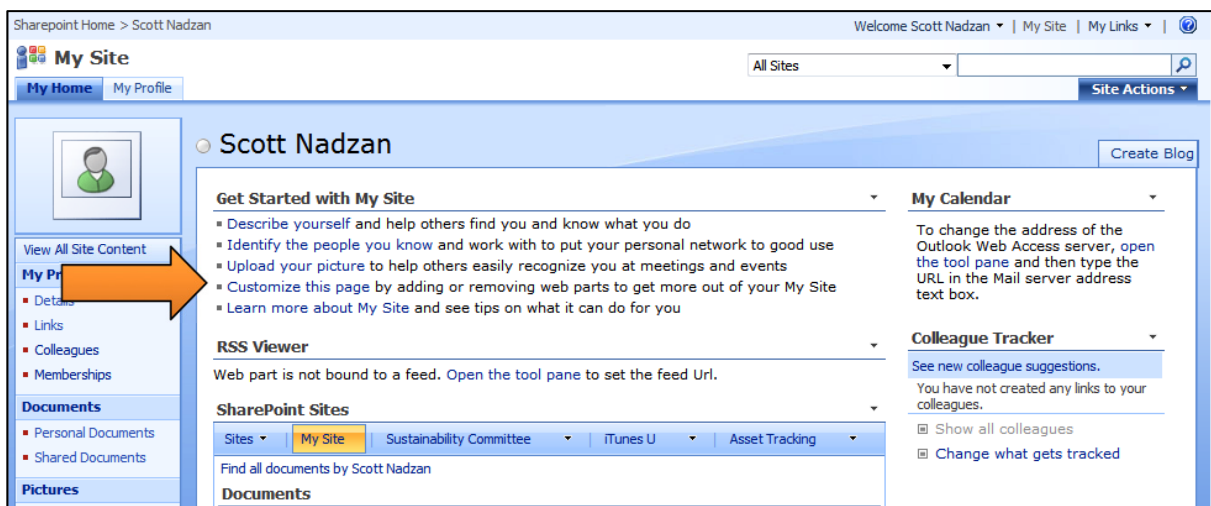
Login and navigate to your SharePoint Site

Login to SharePoint and click on My Site in the top-right navigation.



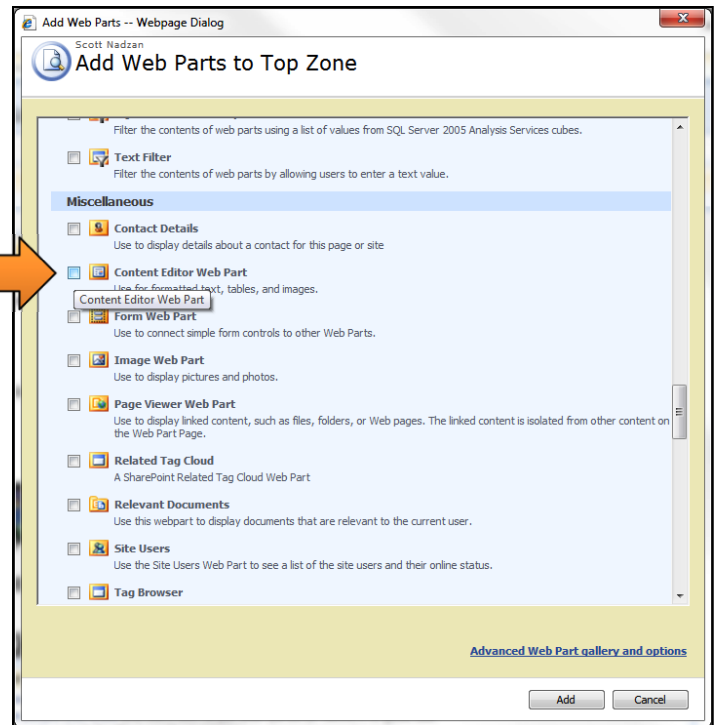
Customize this Page

Once you are in your SharePoint site, click on the Customize this page link.



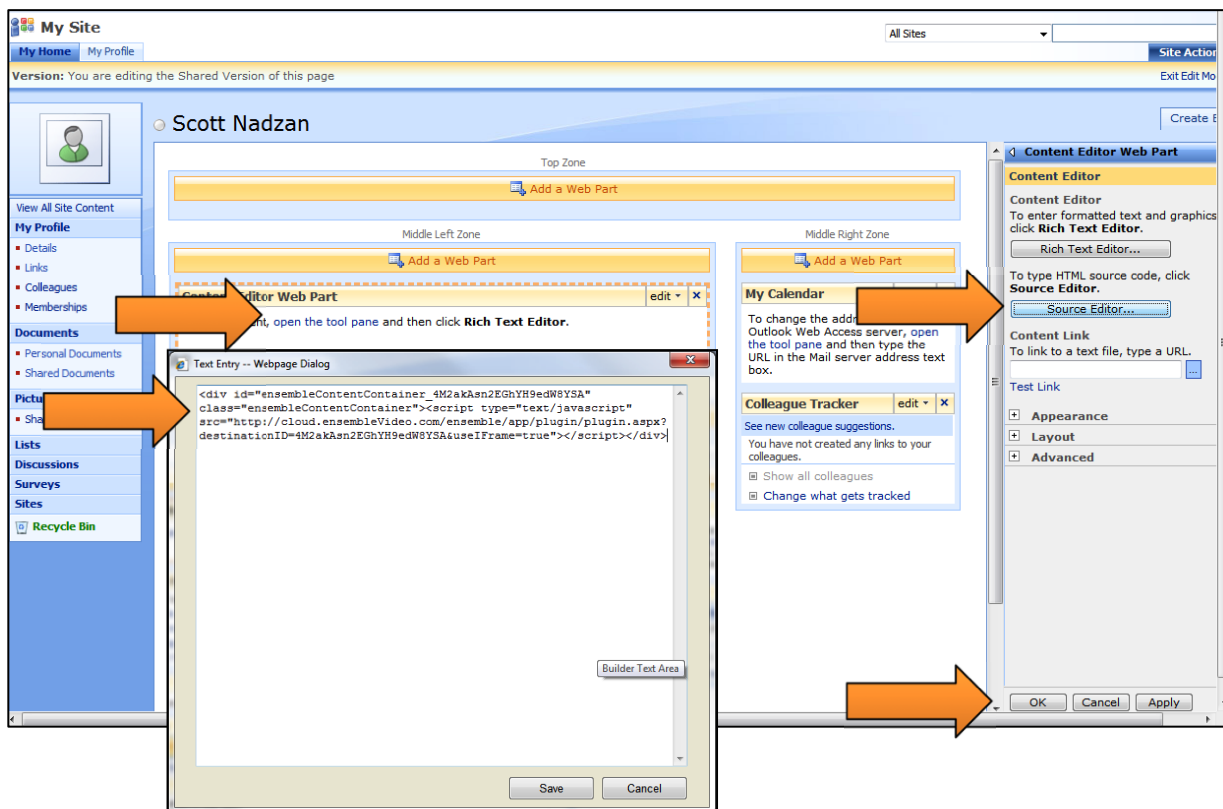
Choose the Content Editor Web Part

Scroll down and choose the Content Editor Web Part. It is in the Miscellaneous Area.



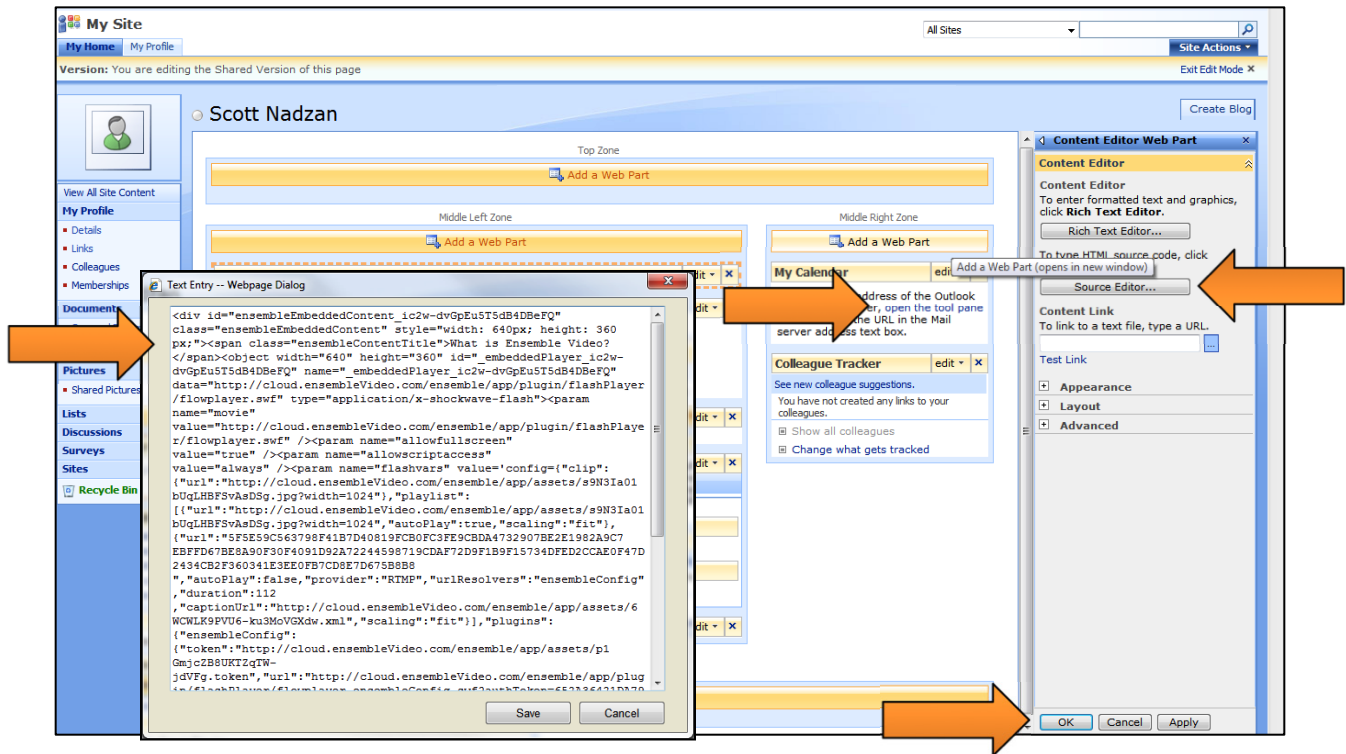
Insert HTML Plug-in Code for Multiple Video List

Select the Web Part you would like to edit. Click on open the tool pane link. Then click on Source Editor in the tool pane. You can then paste your HTML Plug-in code or Embed Code. Click Save and OK your Changes.



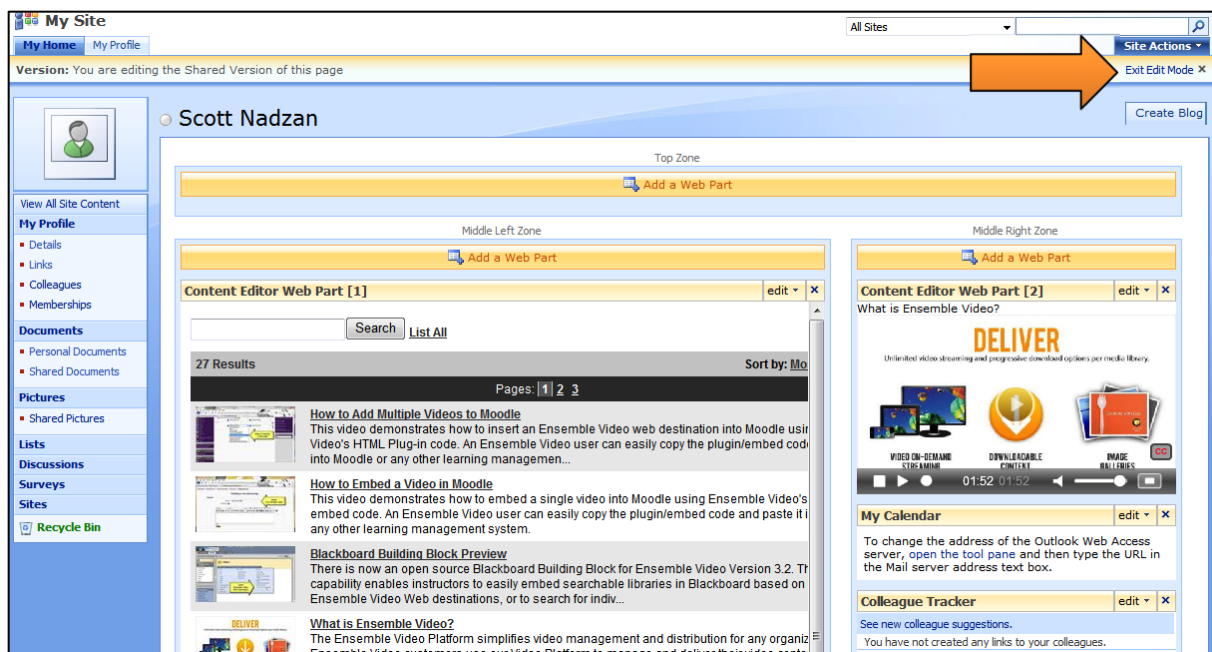
Insert Embed Code for Single Video

Select the Web Part you would like to edit. Click on open the tool pane link. Then click on Source Editor in the tool pane. You can then paste your HTML Plug-in code or Embed Code. Click Save and OK your Changes.




Exit Edit Mode
